I have been in Las Vegas over the last week for a business conference. It's been an incredible journey reconnecting with familiar faces and soaking in some unforgettable experiences. This trip has also been a moment of deep reflection, especially when mapping out the next steps in business and life.

In this week's newsletter, I am presenting a scenario I have been pondering in the form of a story:

The lady, let's call her Elara, stood at the bottom of a golden ladder, gazing up at a tantalizing new realm above, and she felt the anticipation of exploring the unknown. Eagerly, she began to climb, each rung bringing her closer to the bright border of the new realm.

As she ascended, the world around her transformed. The air filled with a sense of possibility, and she could almost taste the adventures that awaited her.

Just as she was about to take the final step into the new realm, a group of workers materialized out of thin air. They began installing a sunroof, obstructing her path. It was a sudden and unexpected obstacle; Confusion clouded Elara's mind as she watched the workers diligently hammering and welding, creating an obstacle in her path just as she was on the cusp of a new adventure.

She hesitated, wondering whether to wait patiently for the workers to finish their tasks or to confront them and demand passage. The workers, absorbed in their duties, paid little attention to her. Frustration gnawed at her as she clung to the ladder, torn between patience and impatience. It was extremely uncomfortable holding on to the ladder and waiting, and she was already a little tired from the energy she had exerted climbing to that point.

Unable to endure the uncertainty any longer, she called out to the workers, inquiring how long the work would take. Their nonchalant "We do not know" response only fueled her frustration. She couldn't comprehend why they had chosen this precise moment to install the sunroof, knowing it would impede her progress.

In annoyance, she demanded an explanation, wanting to know why they chose the precise moment she was about to ascend to start the work. Could they not have waited for her to pass? But the workers remained silent. Frustrated and unwilling to wait indefinitely, she decided to descend the ladder. The realm she had glimpsed from above seemed elusive and distant once more.

Was this unforeseen obstruction a mere redirection, prompting her to explore an alternative path or a formidable hurdle to overcome? As for whether she was wrong for not waiting, it's subjective. Her frustration was valid, given the lack of communication and the unexpected delay. However, patience might have unveiled a purpose behind the workers' actions.

What would you do? Would you attempt to communicate with the workers more effectively, seeking understanding and a compromise? If waiting became unbearable, would you explore other options or find a way to collaborate with the workers to expedite the process?
