We are in the middle of June, Mamas. Can you believe it? There are two days until the official start of summer. We welcome the warmth of summer, and today, we acknowledge a massive moment in the history of the United States of America—Juneteenth. This day

marks a celebration of freedom and a call to remember the profound impact of individual actions, whether seen or unseen.

Juneteenth marks the day in 1865 when the last enslaved people in Texas learned they were free, two years after the Emancipation Proclamation.

This day, June 19th, teaches us about the value of liberation and the strength found in communities, reminding us that significant change often starts with the quiet courage of individuals. For many of you, the journey to fulfill your purpose and achieve goals may sometimes feel overwhelming, especially when your efforts aren't always visible to the world.
